BRIEF INTRODUCTION

Yingli College, the only higher educational institution of Longleng District, was established by the Association of Phom Graduates and Officer (APGO) on September 09, 1992, and it was taken over by the Government of Nagaland w.e.f., February 01, 2006. In the beginning, the college was functioning at the Old ADC Office (Leinak ward) as the academic building. The college started with PU under North Eastern Hill University, Shillong and the Undergraduate Course (General) was introduced in 1995 when college came under Nagaland University. The college was shifted in 2004 from Old ADC Colony to the permanent campus, which is now located in a sprawling area of 52.47 acres of land donated by the Bhumnyu Village Council at Longongkang Campus, 2 kilometres away from Longleng district headquarters. The college adopted 'Longongkang Campus', as the official name for its permanent campus. The college has well maintained infrastructure; safe and walled campus, ICT-enabled classrooms, girls and boys hostels, indoor stadium, spacious library, football, volley ball and basket ball grounds, horticulture farm, herbal garden etc. The college is a WIFI enabled campus.

Yingli College is permanently affiliated to Nagaland University. It is recognized by UGC, and it comes under Section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 since 2011. The institution has been awarded 'B+' grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in May 2022. In addition to the Undergraduate General Course, it offers Honours Programmes in Political Science, History, Economics, Education, English and Sociology. The college hosts National Institute of Electronic and Information Technology (NIELIT) and the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) centres. Since its inception, the college has produced a number of quality graduates, thereby marching ahead in achieving its goal of imparting quality education to the learners. The motto of the college is 'striving for excellence'.

VISION & MISSION

Yingli College was established with the vision of imparting and spreading the light of knowledge to the people of socio-economically underdeveloped region of Nagaland. The institution also sets the visions: to enhance social and environmental awareness, to work for nation building and to develop skills among the youths.

In the midst of numerous hurdles, the college has been marching forward steadily towards all round development in the field of academic, extra-curricular and co-curricular activities. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

ADMISSION

- Admission is opened to all students, who are eligible for higher studies irrespective of tribe, caste, creed, religion, etc.
- Admission will commence on the date as announced by the college authority.
- Prospectus and Admission Form admission will be available from the college during office on the payment of Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred only)
- Candidates must submit the following documents along with the application form.
- Attested copy of the mark sheet of the last examination passed (3 copies)
- Attested copy of the admit card of the HSLC/HSSLC exam (3 copies)
- Attested copy of the certificate stating the result from the head of the institution last attended.
- A certificate from an administrative officer that he / she is a member of schedule caste/schedule tribe, indigenous inhabitant/ differently-abled (3 copies)
- Recently taken passport size photograph (3 copies)
- Duly filled application form accompanied by necessary documents should reach the college office on or before such date as may be notified by the principal.
- A candidate must produce all the original documents at the time of admission
- Selection of candidates for admission will be made by the Admission Committee.
- New Admission fee is free for those students who secured 80% and above in higher secondary exam. Admission fee is also free for differently-abled students provided that they submit certificate from appropriate authority.

Number of Seats Earmarked for Reserved Category

In the absence of a seat reservation policy from the Directorate of Higher Education, Nagaland, Yingli College adheres to the following

- The college is located in a region mainly inhabited by tribal people, as such almost all students seeking admission to the institution is from that Scheduled Tribe. Hence, there is no specific reservation of seats for ST.
- The Internal quality assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college has fixed 300 seats for BA 1st Semester admission and reserved 23 seats for SC, OBC,DA and the students having outstanding records in extra-curricular activities.

REGISTRATION AND MIGRATION

Newly admitted students are to be registered with the Nagaland University. Students who have passed their qualifying examinations outside the jurisdiction of Nagaland University are required to submit Migration Certificate from their previous Board/Council or University.

IDENTITY CARD

College identity card will be issued to all the students after taking admission to the college.

ATTENDANCE

A student must obtain the required percentage of attendance as per the rules of the Nagaland University. A student whose percentage falls below 75% will not be eligible to appear in the final examination.

EXAMINATION

- The college follows semester system of examinations, which consists of internal and external assessment.
- Internal assessment is done by the college, while external assessment/examination is done by the Nagaland University.
- End term, internal examinations and seminars are held regularly.
- A student who is found guilty of adopting unfair means of any sort during examination or misbehaving in any other manner in the final examination hall render himself/herself liable for expulsion.
- It is compulsory on the part of the student to appear all the examinations conducted by the college from time to time. Failure to appear in the examination on the strength of medical certificate will not be criteria for consideration.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The college maintains a library which provides basic reading facilities to both students and teachers. The automation of the college library is in the process. Students are required to follow library rules and regulation while utilizing the facilities. E-books and e-journal are made accessible to the readers. The library offers printing and xerox facilities to the visitors. Students will collect library card after admission.

SCHOLARSHIP

The State Government offers post-matric scholarships to students belonging to SC/ST and other scholarships for meritorious students. Students are required to observe strict discipline and show regularity in attendance, failing which their scholarship may be forfeited.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The college follows self-framed academic calendar which includes academic and co-curricular activities, celebration of various international/national days, holidays, etc.

HOSTELS

Hostel facilities are available for both boys and girls. After admission, students can collect hostel admission form from the office. Admission fee, security money and monthly mess fess shall be decided by the college administration for hostellers.

DISCIPLINE

Code of Conduct for Students

- Damaging college property is a punishable offence.
- Students are not allowed to collect money to raise any fund in the name of the college without prior permission of the principal.
- Students must attend the classes regularly and the college may debar a student from appearing end term examination if his/her attendance falls short as per college or university rules. Participation in college extra-curricular activities is compulsory.
- To ensure cleanliness of college campus, students will not use non-biodegradable materials and will throw wastes in proper place provided for that purpose. They should avoid any activity that causes air, water and land pollution.
- No student(s) must use any banned intoxicants including pan, pan-masala, smoking, alcohol, tobacco, misuse of any other drugs.
- All students must come to college with clean and decent dress and in uniform. They will come to college in traditional attire on Wednesday, as decided by the department of higher education, government of Nagaland.
- Students are not allowed to use phone or any other gadgets when the teachers are inside the class. Violators shall be punished by confiscating their gadgets by the principal.
- Students are not allowed to hold meetings or take part in processions without permission from the administration.
- Students will not join any terrorist group banned by the college or Centre or State governments.
- Unauthorized persons are not allowed to carry any weapon, ammunition, explosives, and fireworks within the college campus.
- Students will not invite media persons to the college campus without permission from the principal. They must be careful while using social media and avoid from giving derogatory remarks against the college fraternity.
- Without permission students are not allowed to take audio or video records of the lectures delivered in the class nor that of any functions held in the college or related to the college.
- Plagiarism: Plagiarism is an offence. So, nobody should use the data, idea, etc of others (from sources such as internet, thesis, journal, book, report, etc) without referring to original source. Even if the author takes help from his/her earlier published work, the person should give appropriate citations. So, the students should be careful while submitting any assignment or preparing report and give due acknowledgement of others if any.
- A student will not sign on behalf of other student(s)/friend(s) on the assignment(s)/report(s) or while filling in the examination/ admission forms.
- Cheating: Students found mal-practicing during internal or external examination shall be expelled.
- Anti-Ragging: A student whether senior or junior shall not harass other fellow student(s) mentally, physically or emotionally. A student will not tease another student in the name of religion, region, private life, differently-abled, caste, colour, etc. If reported, the Anti-Ragging Cell of Yingli College will investigate the complaints and take action.
- Male students will not harass female students and vice versa, students indulging in bullying or harassment shall be expelled.
- Failure to adhere to the above rules shall invite penalties like detention, expulsion etc and the college authority has the final say in the code of conduct of the students.
